



Skeeball Rules

PLAYERS

- There are no gender requirements. Just roll. *Keep in mind that if you know your team will be short players that subs are encouraged except for finals night.*
- Players can only enter a second heat after at least 3 other players on their team have rolled.

NIGHTLY FORMAT

- Each night will contain 3 waves
- Each wave lasts approximately 1 hour
- Each wave has 8 Heats
- Heats consists of 3 Frames, each team will roll in 4 of them. The referee will announce which teams are rolling before each heat begins.
- A Frame consists of 9 rolled balls
- 4 teams will be represented in each Heat. Different players can roll in the same heat.

SCORING

- At the end of each frame points will awarded to each "roller".
 - 10 points for 1st place
 - 7 points for 2nd
 - 5 points for 3rd
 - 3 points for 4th
- At the end of the Heat (3 frames rolled) points are totaled and awarded to teams.
- Points accumulate over the course of the season and are used to determine playoff seeding

START AND END OF THE HEAT

- The frame starts when all 4 players are set, and the first ball is rolled. The frame ends when all players have rolled all 9 balls.
- A Heat closes when all 3 frames have ended.
